## NOTICE OF RACE Rev.1

### Rules:

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the current edition of the US Sailing Racing Rules of Sailing (2009-2012), as modified by Appendix E, Sailing Instructions, and the AMYA Micro Magic class rules (International Micro Magic Class Rules Version 4 – 1 Jan 09).

### Eligibility:

The regatta is open to all boats of the Micro Magic Class whose owners are current members of AMYA, or National Organization of their country, who are also properly registered with the Class and comply with AMYA class rules.

**Location:** Racing will be held at the pond at Firkin & Kegler, Orlando FL, detailed directions to the event will be provided on the club website [www.sundaysloopers.com](http://www.sundaysloopers.com) or via email if requested.

**Entry:** Eligible boats may be entered by completing the attached Entry Form (or separate entry document on website) and submitting it prior to October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010 with the entry fee indicated on the entry form. An email confirmation of entry is sufficient to meet the October 1<sup>st</sup> deadline but the form and fee must be received one week after email notification. If room is available late entries may be accepted with a \$5 late fee. Entries will be limited to 32 boats.

**Sailing Instructions:** Sailing instructions will be posted on the club website and frequency assignments will be posted on the website at the conclusion of the entry time period.

**Rule changes:** RRS rule changes, if any, may be posted on the website and/or described at the skippers meeting(s)

**Racing format:** The race committee will determine the number of races for each day after considering weather, course and equipment conditions. Course length will be considered to attain as many races as possible under given conditions. Two (2) races are required to be completed to constitute the regatta. After approximately 20 boats are entered the fleet may sail under the odd/even multiple fleet format. Probable courses may be windward/leeward with offset marks, Olympic or others to meet conditions; however some wind directions may necessitate downwind starts.

**Scoring:** The regatta will be scored in accordance with the Low Point Scoring system as set forth in Appendix A of the Racing Rules of Sailing. Throwouts will be allowed, with the number of races per throwout to be determined by the RD allowing for weather conditions and announced at the Skippers Meeting on Saturday, a limit of two throwouts will be allowed. Allowable throwouts will be defined in the Sailing Instructions.

**Prizes:** Prizes will be awarded to at least the top three (3) finishers. In addition, this is a Gold Chevron Event for the AMYA Class

**Measurements:** Measurement and class authenticity verification will be conducted on-site on all boats during check-in and registration. Award winning boats may also be measured post regatta. At no time will changes to the boats be made during the regatta, with the exception of those allowed under the class rules. Any necessary changes to a boat for damage etc. will be with like parts in design and weight and done with the approval of the RD. Any boat making unauthorized changes is subject to disqualification from the regatta. Boats requiring correction weight to bring their weight up to the class minimum will be re-weighed; amount and location of weights noted and shall not be moved for the duration of the event. Sail numbers displayed on mainsail will be full class provided sail number and country designation per Micro Magic Class Rule 5.4.
